The Usha Mittal Institute of Technology (UMIT) at SNDT Women's University, renowned for its specialized engineering courses and preferred by leading software companies both nationally and internationally, recently celebrated its Silver Jubilee. The institute organized a series of events to commemorate this milestone, including a week-long program of technical and non-technical workshops and activities. Distinguished guests in attendance included the esteemed Pro Vice Chancellor of SNDT Women's University, Prof. Ruby Ojha, Dr. Satayanarana, Scientific Officer at TIFR, and Mr. Vishram Bapat from Data Bytes Solutions, among others.

In the academic year 2022-2023, UMIT expanded its range of programs by introducing a new branch dedicated to Artificial Intelligence. This field, rapidly growing across industries, equips students with advanced computer skills and a comprehensive understanding of its applications in various sectors.

Another significant achievement during this period was the installation of a Solar Powered Weather Station by Usha Mittal Institute of Technology in collaboration with City University of New York (CUNY) on January 2nd, 2023. This collaborative project, part of the academic collaboration agreement between the two universities, aims to monitor air pollution and weather conditions on a micro-scale in Mumbai. The installation ceremony was graced by the honorable Vice Chancellor, Prof. Ujwala Chakradeo.

UMIT has always emphasized and supported research endeavors, and in the year 2022-23, the faculty members successfully secured eight minor and one major research projects in emerging and related technologies.

UMIT attracted numerous companies for internships and placements, with the highest internship compensation offered at 75,000 per month and a placement offer of 19.63 lakhs.
