General Queries

1. What is the DTE Code of Usha Mittal Institute of Technology (UMIT)?

DTE Code is 3035.

2. UMIT belongs to which University?

UMIT is managed by SNDT Women's University.

3. Where is the college located?

UMIT is located in Santacruz (West), Mumbai, Maharashtra.

4. What are the eligibility requirements for B.Tech. admission? How to register and from where do I get the application?

Refer to the Directorate of Technical Education (DTE) website www.mahacet.org and UMIT website <http://umit.ac.in> regularly.

5. What is CAP round?

CAP stands for Centralized Admission Process. It is conducted by the Directorate of Technical Education or Government of Maharashtra. Allotment of seats through CAP are not done by the institute. Seats are allotted through an online portal of DTE.

6. Are there any schemes belonging to students of minority communities?

UMIT is a non-minority institution.

Hence there are no separate schemes for minority communities.

11. Is there any Reservation in seats allotment ?

Reservation in seats is applicable as per the Government Rules for CAP rounds conducted by DTE. However, there is no reservation in institute quota seats, which are open for all and filled strictly by merit basis only.

12. Is there a separate category for children of Defense personnel?

Reservation is only available in CAP rounds as per DTE rules.

Yes. Your admission is confirmed only when you pay the fees as applicable and submit all the required documents in original. If you don't have all the originals while taking admission then you will be given some time to submit those documents.

19. Is it possible to change the branch in the second year?

Technically Yes. There should be a vacancy at that point of time. Allotment will be on a first year merit list basis. It is not recommended to take admission in a particular branch on the futuristic assumptions of change in branch.

20. I got very few marks and I'm not sure whether I will get admission at UMIT?

Do not make assumptions based on prior cut-offs. You should apply and keep patience till the last cutoff date declared by DTE. Sometimes seat may get vacant at the last moment and you may get a chance to fill that seat. So do not lose hope.

21. I have not applied at UMIT and the admission process is over. Now will I get a seat at UMIT?

No. Once the admission process is over then there is no further scope for admissions. However you should always see notifications by DTE.
